Facility Rules, Regulations and Policies for Photographers

Welcome to Fanshawe Pioneer Village. We are pleased that our Village has been selected for this special occasion. Our Village is a living history Museum and therefore there are some guidelines to keep in mind when using the site.

1. Please respect the Museum's irreplaceable historic environment and honour our responsibility to preserve the past for future generations. Some requests may have to be denied or adjusted which can never specifically be outlined in a contract or agreement. Museum property, especially items in the Village's collections may not be moved or altered in any way except by permission of the Curator.
2. There is no electrical service in many of the buildings or outside of the buildings: please plan on using battery powered equipment.
3. Modern Vehicles are not allowed on site between the hours of 10 am and 4:30 pm. If you need access to bring in equipment please arrange with the Coordinator to obtain access via the special entrances.
4. May we suggest you make an appointment with the Rental Coordinator to view the site prior to the Event. This will help you determine the best photographic locations for the client.
5. During the usual operating hours for the Village the public is allowed free access to all the Village sites that are accessible. The Church will be closed for any ceremony taking place for that period of time.
6. The client (or the photographer) may take photographs during any Event. However the client is not granted a copyright license to use such pictures for commercial use. Photos are permitted in the Labatt Brewery, Trinity church, Miller barn and the Village Café as well as any outdoor locations.
7. Absolutely no smoking in any of the buildings or on the grounds of Fanshawe Pioneer Village.
